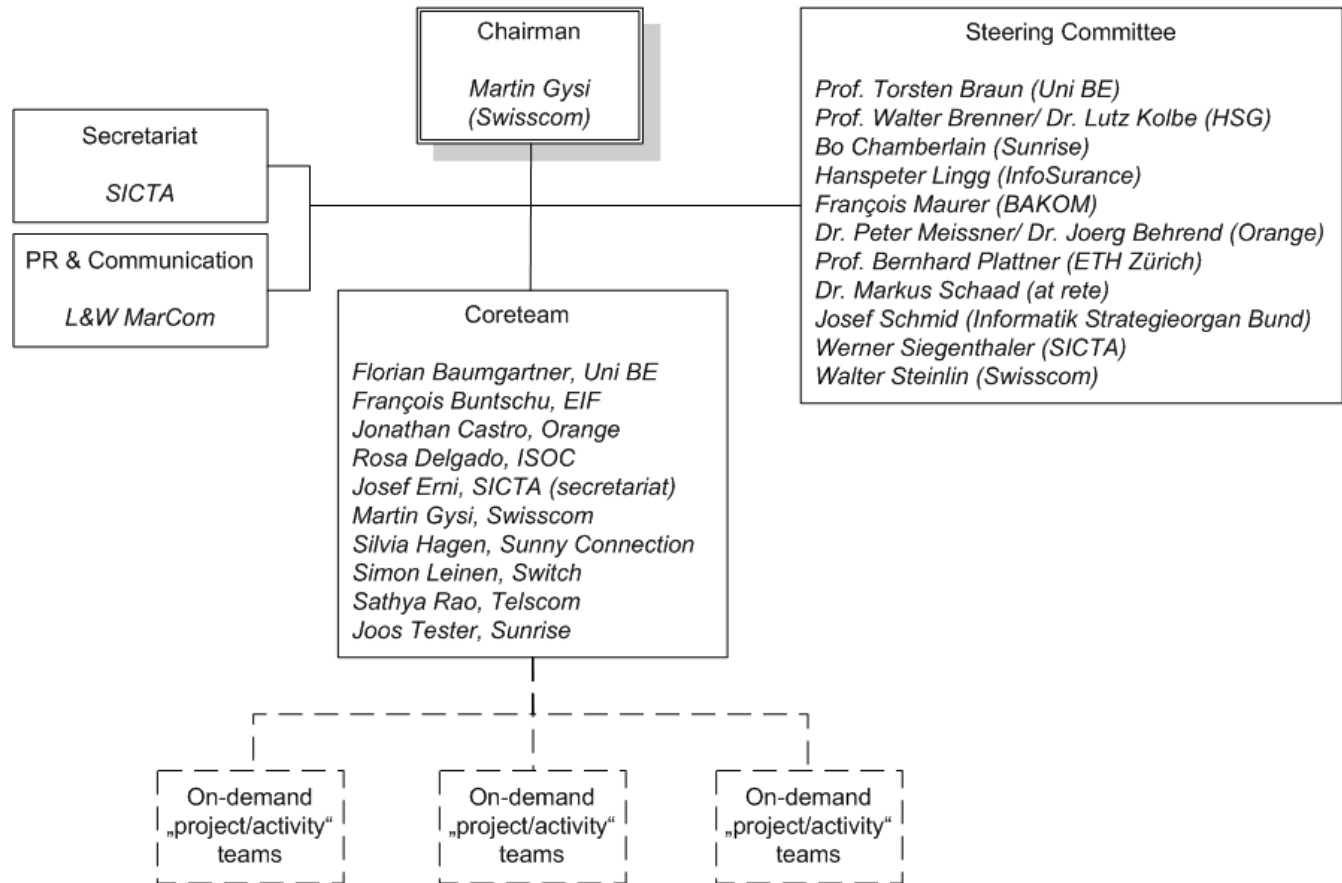
Status of the Swiss IPv6 Task Force

EC IPv6 TF Meeting, 14.01.2003, Brussels

Achievements

- 1st IPv6 Summit Switzerland (24.04.2003), successful
- About 150 persons in mailing list
- First project starting (IPv6 peering with ISPs and IX participating)



Barriers

- No official commitment from government yet (but first reactions starting – eCH thinks about recommending IPv6 for eGovernment in Switzerland)
- Still not enough people know about the importance of IPv6 and that it is here today
- No customer demand

Next Steps

- Start more projects in 2004 (**to spread out IPv6, to have a stable IPv6 network in Switzerland**):
 - Operator interoperability:
 - Roaming between operators (SLAs, service discovery, Mobile IPv6, AAA)
 - IPv6 QoS
 - Inter-operability testing for IPv6 applications
- Started organization of 2nd IPv6 Summit Switzerland on 3rd of June 2004 (**to raise more awareness and to report that IPv6 is feasible today**)
- Convince the government, big news paper, big company to announce their commitment for IPv6 (**to show that „some trusted entity“ is doing IPv6**)
